



Caljan & All Extendo Safety Memo

Some WyCo Services customers consider Extendos a confined space when you have to access the inside of these units. Caljan does have an exemption stating that their unit is not a confined space unit. **WyCo Services will rule all Extendos as confined space units.**

Any time you must access the inside of these units, the WyCo Services Confined Space Policies must be followed. Please refer to the Safety Management Plan for additional information.

When servicing the inside of Extendos, all access panels need to be removed with two people at minimum present, with one person being on watch. **The person on watch must remain in constant visual of the technician within the confined space.** If you are by yourself, then the customer will have to provide an employee to provide watch for you. **If no one is available for watch, you are not permitted to enter the inside of the machine.**

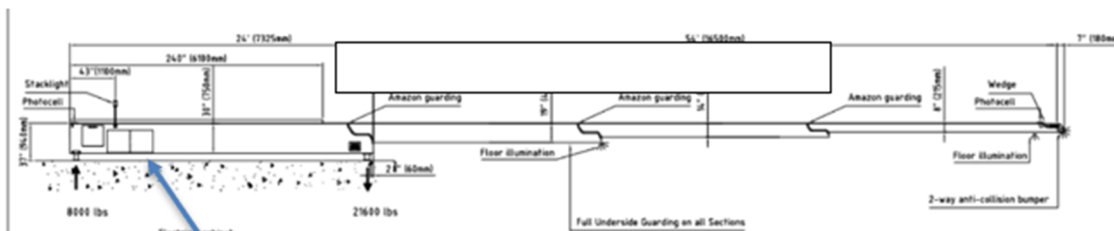
To enter a Caljan (or any Extendo), all WyCo Confined Space Policies must be followed and Lock Out/Tag Out must be used, and all access panels are to be removed. A minimum of two (2) people are required to be present, with one (1) person outside as a watch at all times.
